Due to the abrupt nature of the government order that we received on Thursday March, 20th to close our operation, Classic Rock Fabrication has filed for a special exemption, which would allow our company to complete any projects that are currently in progress. In a situation such as this, we feel that it extremely important for the health and well-being of our customers, that they have fully operational kitchens. It is not our intent, or our desire to leave any projects incomplete, as your safety is important to us during this time of crisis.

However, we must comply with the government order, and receive this exemption before next steps are taken. We do not know how long this will take, and whether permission will be granted to us. But please rest assured that our company is working very hard behind the scenes for you.

Classic Rock Fabrication in Harrisburg, Mechanicsburg and Pittsburgh will cease all operations effective 8pm on Thursday March 19th, in cooperation with direct orders from Pennsylvania Governor, Tom Wolf. Information is limited at this time, however we fully intend to comply with this government order, directed to all non-life sustaining businesses in the state of Pennsylvania.

All scheduled activities including templates, services and installations will be placed on hold at this time, and all manufacturing operations at Classic Rock will discontinue. Our offices and showrooms will be closed until further notice.

Our dedicated sales representatives and project managers, as well as our entire management team, will be available to assist our customers in the coming weeks. We will continue to monitor all phone calls and emails remotely, in an effort to provide support to our customers during this closure.

And as more information becomes available, we will plan to stay in touch with you and keep you informed. We will work very hard to re-build our schedule, for when the government restrictions have been lifted and our business is permitted to operate again.

We would like to take this opportunity in all sincerity, to thank our valued customers, trade partners and employees for their commitment and support. We love and care for you deeply, and we wish you and your families good health and strength in the coming weeks.
